



Use of Tobacco Products, Alcohol, Unlawful Drugs, Inhalant Delivery Systems or Mind-Altering Substances

Substance abuse, being found under the influence, possession, use, distribution, sale or intent to distribute or sell tobacco products, inhalant delivery systems (including electronic cigarettes), alcohol or unlawful drugs or mind-altering substances, including drug paraphernalia or any substance purported to be a federally unlawful drug or mind- altering substance, on or near any Organizational Property, (includes facilities, premises and property in use by or under the control of the Organization, if the member or staff is at any event approved, activity or function related to the Organization, Drum Corps International, or WGI where members are under the control of the Organization or where the staff member is engaged in Organization business) is prohibited and will result in disciplinary action up to and including dismissal from the Organization.

An individual may be referred to law enforcement officials. For members below the age of majority, parents will be notified of all violations involving their member and subsequent action taken by the Organization.

Clothing, bags, hats and other personal items used to display, promote or advertise tobacco products, inhalant delivery systems, alcohol, marijuana or drugs are prohibited on all Organizational Property

An "unlawful drug" is any drug as defined by the Controlled Substances Act including, but not limited to, marijuana, cocaine, opiates, amphetamines and phencyclidine (PCP). A mind-altering substance includes, but is not limited to, inhalants, propellant aerosol sprays, etc. A look-a-like is a common household product, substance, or a drug-like substance, alleged to be a mind-altering substance (e.g., aspirin, herbs, etc.). As used in this policy, an unlawful drug also means possession, use, sale or supply of prescription and nonprescription drugs in violation of Board policy and any accompanying administrative regulation.
